Established in 1980, Open Door provides food, clothing, referral information and emergency funding to men, women, children and seniors in need. We service people in Waterford, White Lake, West Bloomfield, Keego Harbor, Sylvan Lake, Commerce, Orchard Lake, Walled Lake, Wolverine Lake and Wixom.

• FOOD PANTRY

Open Door's client-choice food pantry provides food, personal care items and even pet food, on a monthly basis to qualified income families and individuals struggling to make ends meet. Seasonal programs are also offered such as holiday meals, back-to-school and summer feeding programs.

• CLIENT SERVICES

Open Door also provides emergency services of clothing and referral information to families in need. Crisis assistance can include emergency funds utility shutoffs, prescriptions, rent, to fix vehicles, stop evictions and more. Many are facing eviction or are even homeless. • THRIFT STORE

Donated items such as clothing and household items are sold in the resale shop which is staffed by volunteers. All proceeds are used to support operational costs of the Outreach Center. In addition, resale clothing and household items are distributed to people in need.
